

**BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
ADJOURNED MEETING  
MARCH 2, 2005**

At an adjourned meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Floyd County, Virginia, held on Wednesday, March 2, 2005 at 6:00 p.m. in the Board Room of the County Administration Building, thereof;

PRESENT: David W. Ingram, Chairman; J. Fred Gerald, Vice Chairman; Diane B. Belcher, Jerry W. Boothe, Kerry W. Whitlock, Board Members; George W. Nester, County Administrator; Terri W. Morris, Assistant County Administrator.

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

A work session on the proposed FY06 budget was held.

Sheriff Shannon Zeman appeared before the Board to present additional information related to his budget requests. His main requests were for County-funded salary supplements for his staff and additional funds for holiday repayment. He presented a proposed scale outlining the distribution of the supplements by years of service. He also outlined all the other types of services provided to the citizens that are not legally required of his office, but are done as part of public relations, such as funeral traffic direction, traffic control at events such as the Christmas parade, proper installation of child car seats, etc. He also discussed the vehicle replacements that were needed this year.

After the Sheriff's departure, the Board further discussed the proposed budget, with emphasis on the expenditure side, since few revenue figures have been received from the State at this time.

On a motion of Supervisor Whitlock, seconded by Supervisor Boothe, and unanimously carried, it was resolved to adjourn.
