Water Source Issues:

- Educating Well Owners of Inspection Requirements
- Determining location and depths of Wells in the County (create database)
- Locating new sources of Water
- Feasibility of Surface Water Systems
- Updating Ordinances to encourage proper placement of wells
- Rain water Retention
- Utilizing different Funding Sources for PSA systems
- Educating homeowners on BMP's in a "clearing house"

Sewer Issues:

- Feasibility Study of PSA accepting septic waste
- Encouraging decentralized systems w/ PSA as maintenance authority
- Educating Owners of maintenance issues and BMP's
- Updating Ordinances to meet current demands (?)
- Identifying the needs going forwards (examples include Schools and Willis Area)
- Operator issues at the schools and staff turnover problems

Transportation Issues:

- Problem areas:
 - 221 Bridge by Ray's
 - Thunderstruck (Parking for recreational uses)
- Keep Roadways 2 lanes
- Improving Signage for Points of Interest
- Utilizing the Tour De Floyd route for Bikeway mapping
- Alternative Parking Facilities in Floyd
- Increased Parking Facilities in Floyd (especially for events, perhaps using private land)
- Bypass and alternative Routes for Town Events ("safety valve")
- Public Transportation/Transit (start with carpool, vanpool)
- Shuttling
- Alternative Transportation Facilities linking existing Buildings (e.g. trails connecting Recreation Park to Town; Jacksonville Center to Town; Parkway to Town): could include shoulder wedging, bike lanes, pedestrian walkways, trails, etc.
- Increasing the Towns Pedestrian facilities
