WHEREAS, we would like to remember those who help all of us here in the County of Floyd by giving their time to help their neighbor, and thank our heroes – our volunteers, blood donors, class takers and financial supporters who help us assist those in need; and

WHEREAS, in the County of Floyd, the Red Cross works tirelessly through its nine employees and 615 volunteers to help when disaster strikes, when someone needs lifesaving skills or the comfort of a helping hand. It provides 24-hour support to members of the military, veterans and their families, and provides training in CPR, aquatics safety, first aid; and


