- If there are weather-related vaccine clinic schedule changes, follow the instructions provided in email & phone messages to you.
- **Pharmacy Partners:** Vaccines are being provided to some local pharmacies to help provide high priority vaccines close to home for the most vulnerable.

Bring your card. **If your 1st was at the Christiansburg site, Jan. 24 & later**, you have a 2nd appointment. **If your 1st was at another location, please contact them.**

- **Vaccine demand exceeds supply.**
- **Sign up for local vaccine notifications at NRVRoadtoWellness.com.**
- The number of vaccines given now exceeds the number of cumulative COVID-19 cases reported in the district.
- **We administer all available vaccines.** The Health District has the capacity to give at least 1,200 vaccines per day, but the supply is less than full capacity.
- **COVID-19 testing is available** via self-collected nasal swab.
