

## Top Things To Know

- The NRV preregistration system will be down from Friday-Monday (2/12-2/15)** as we integrate with the state's new vaccine registration system.
- New hours for Vaccine Call Center** (540-838-8222): Mon.-Fri., 9 a.m. – 6 p.m., Sat. 9 a.m. – 3 p.m., closed Sun. (Due to high call volumes and low pickups on returned calls, voicemails are not recorded after hours.)
- Please help those aged 75 and up register** for vaccines and get to vaccination appointments.
- Precautions are still important**, even after vaccination. You may still infect others, even if you don't have symptoms. **Wear** a mask. **Watch** your distance. **Wash** your hands.
- Got your 1st dose at the Task Force site in Christiansburg AND **eligible for your 2nd before Feb. 24?** Visit the Task Force site in Christiansburg with your vaccination card any weekday, between 9 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. No appointment needed.

- Today, there are **24** COVID-19-positive patients hospitalized and **0** persons under investigation.
- Pre-registered? What's next?** Please do not call or email to check your status. **Please be patient. You will be contacted ASAP** to make an appointment.
- Once you have an appointment, please keep it.

As reported to VDH, by date of lab report. May differ from other sources, due to reporting lags. Totals are cumulative, since March 2020.

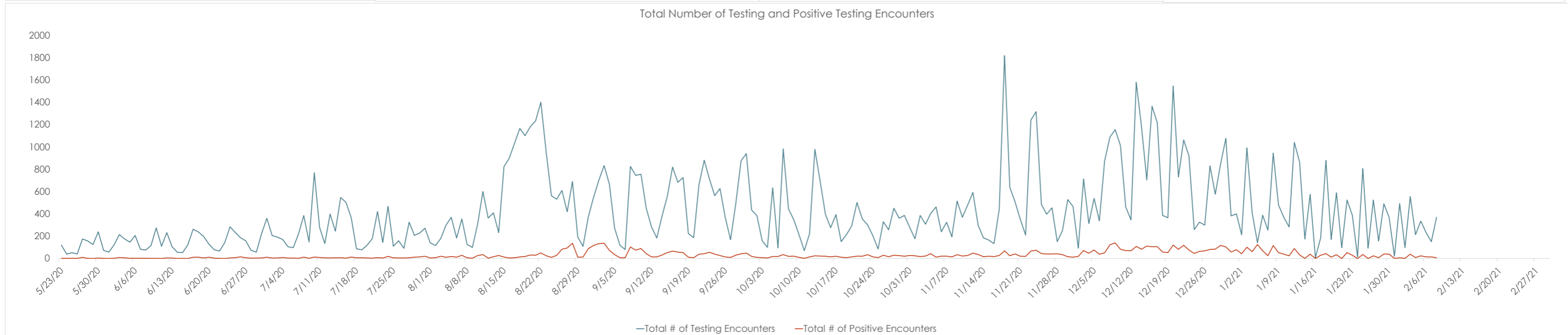
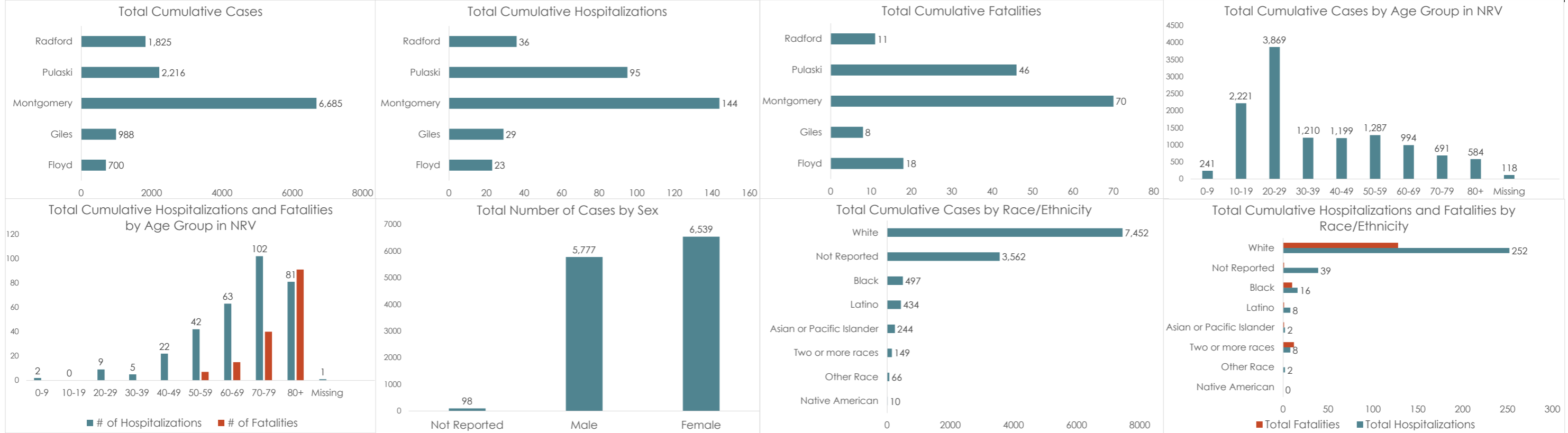

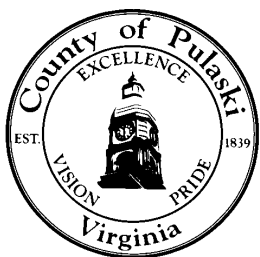
