

Top Things To Know

1. **The NRV preregistration system will be down today-early next week** as we integrate with the state's new vaccine registration system.
2. **New hours for Vaccine Call Center** (540-838-8222): Mon.-Fri., 9 a.m. – 6 p.m., Sat. 9 a.m. – 3 p.m., closed Sun. (Due to high call volumes and low pickups on returned calls, voicemails are not recorded after hours at our local call center.)
3. **Starting today (2/12)**, after hours and when our local Vaccine Call Center phone line is busy, calls will automatically be transferred to the state's call center, which is operational Mon.-Fri., 8 a.m. – 8 p.m.
4. **Precautions are still important**, even after vaccination. **Wear** a mask. **Watch** your distance. **Wash** your hands.
5. Got your 1st dose at the Task Force site in Christiansburg AND **eligible for your 2nd before Feb. 24?** Visit the Task Force site in Christiansburg with your vaccination card any weekday, between 9 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. No appointment needed.

- Today, there are **20** COVID-19-positive patients hospitalized and **0** persons under investigation.
- **Pre-registered? What's next?** Please do not call or email to check your status. **Please be patient. You will be contacted ASAP** to make an appointment.

- **We administer all available vaccines.** We have the capacity to give 1,200 vaccines per day, but we lack supply.
- **Pharmacy Partners:** Vaccines are being provided to some local pharmacies to help provide high priority vaccines close to home for the most vulnerable. Pre-register using NRVRoadtoWellness.com.
- **COVID-19 testing is available** (*There will be NO testing on Mon., Feb. 15*): **Montgomery Co. Health Dept.** in Christiansburg, Mon., Wed. and Fri., 9 – 11 a.m. Appointments required. 540-267-8240.

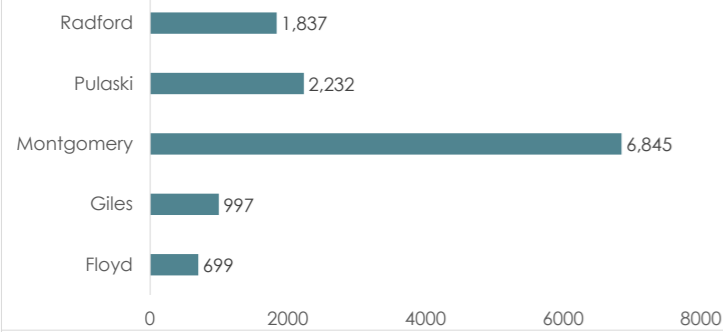

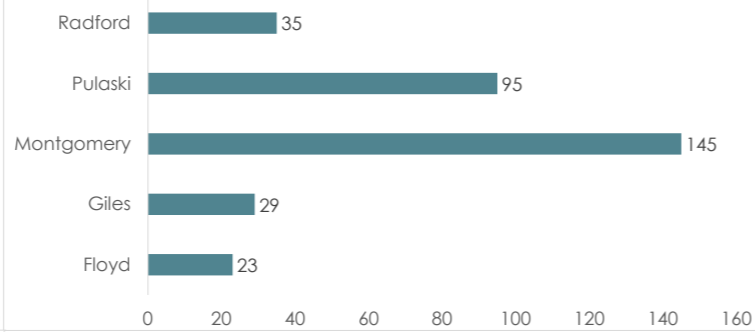

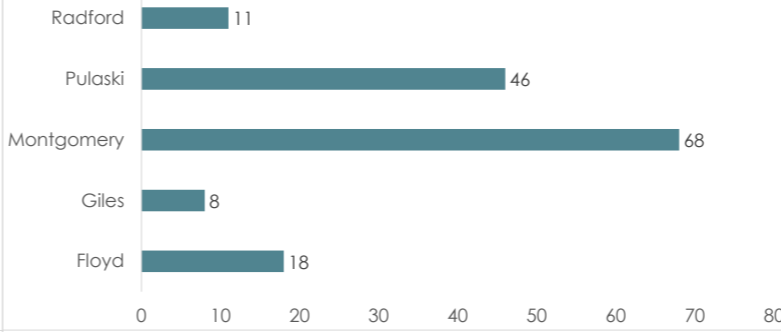
Total Cumulative Cases



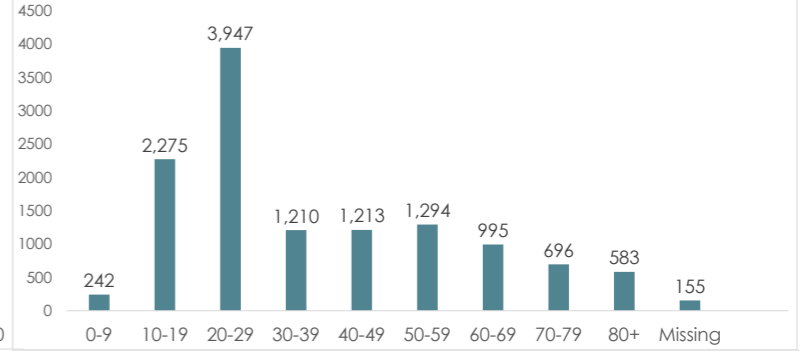
Total Cumulative Hospitalizations



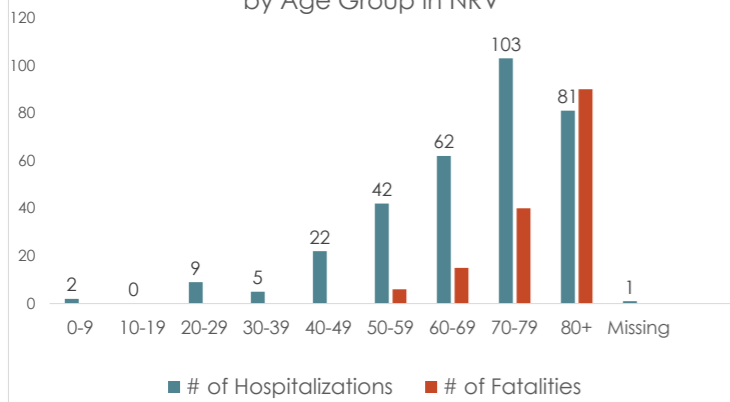
Total Cumulative Fatalities



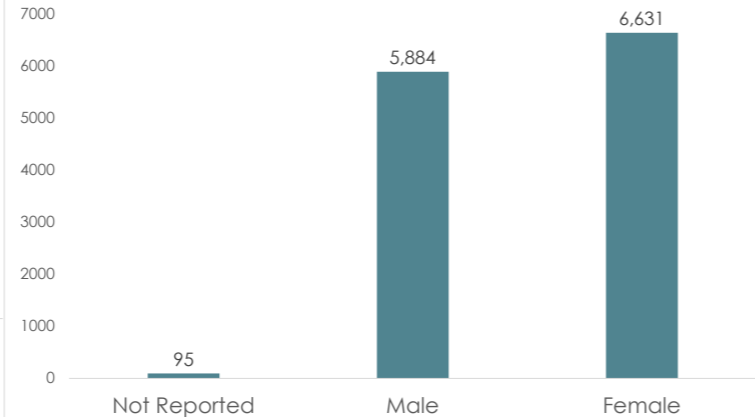
Total Cumulative Cases by Age Group in NRV



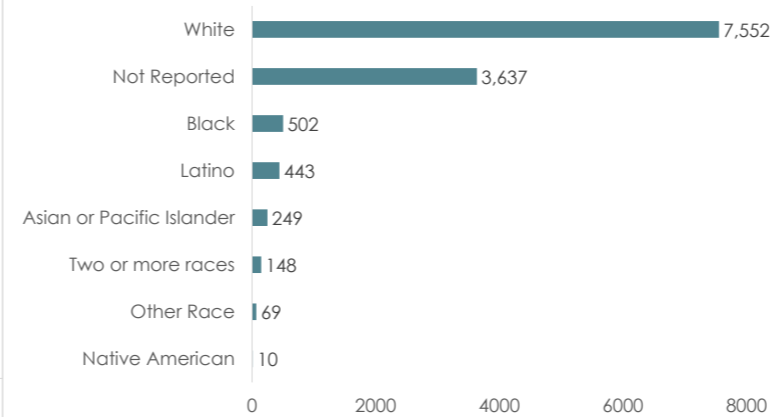
Total Cumulative Hospitalizations and Fatalities by Age Group in NRV



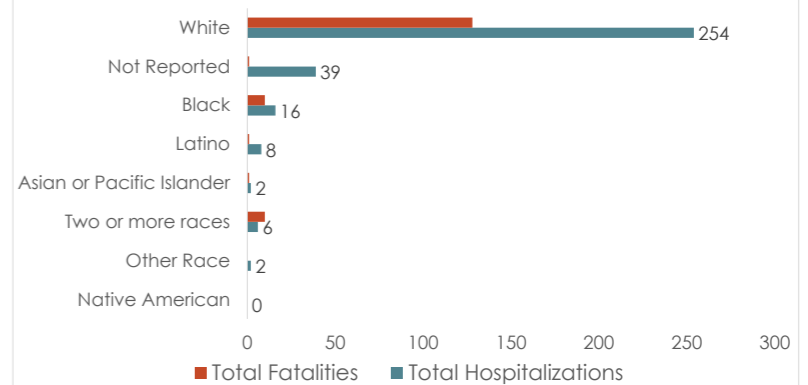
Total Number of Cases by Sex



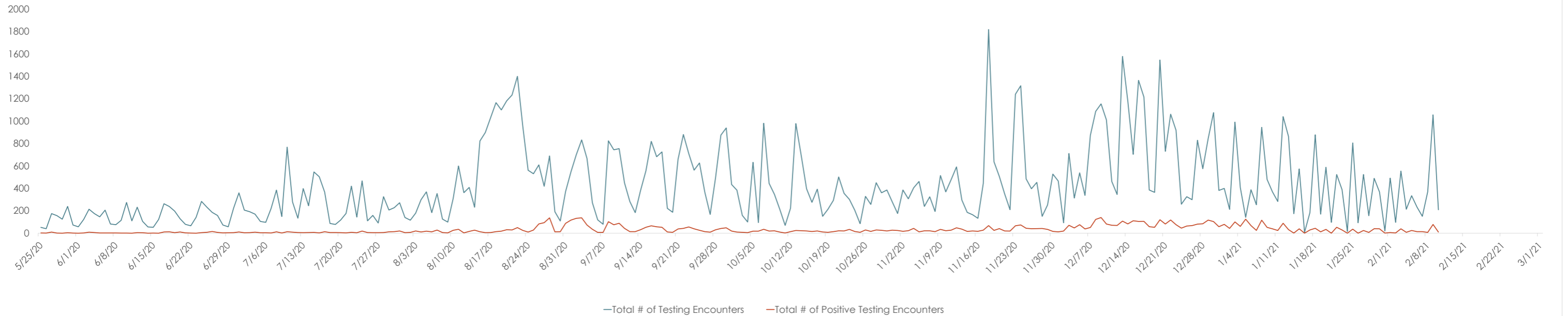
Total Cumulative Cases by Race/Ethnicity
