

Request for Proposals

Clearing work around the Floyd Innovation Center

The Economic Development Authority of Floyd County (EDA) is requesting bids to clear certain areas around the Floyd Innovation Center parking lot (see sketch below). An area about 10 ft wide should be cleared around the parking lot and driveway so it can be mowed in the future; a couple areas may not be feasible to clear or mow because of slope (these will be noted at pre-bid meeting). Any invasives such as autumn olives should be removed with roots and/or treated such that they could be mowed over in the future in this 10 ft strip. If not removed, stumps should be treated with either Candor or Crossbow chemicals. Treatment should be applied by paint brush rather than spray since a major public well is on an adjacent parcel. Evergreens should not be removed, but the ones that reach into the mowing strip should be trimmed. In addition to the 10 ft wide strip, please include a price for an additional 8 hours of work cutting and treating additional invasive trees/bushes behind that 10 ft strip, but not extending behind evergreens.

We will have a pre-bid meeting on Tuesday, Jan 4th at 10 a.m. (Or snow date: Monday, January 10th at 10 a.m.)
